Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016, as Amended Environmental Permit Application: James Russell Ready Mix Concrete

I write in connection with the cement activity at land off Lower Road, Glemsford.

Activities involving the storage and use of cement in bulk require an Environmental Permit under the above regulations, and I advise you that it is an offence to operate a bulk cement activity without the benefit of holding a valid Environmental Permit, therefore I advise you to apply for one promptly.

I enclose a bulk cement activity permit application form for you to complete and return no later than 17:00 on Friday 12th May 2023. Specific guidance can be found on the gov.uk web site using the Internet search "PG 3/1 cement". The guidance contains a model permit which we will base your permit on if your application is successful.

The application fee is £433 (£362 + £71 fee for plant already in operation), and you application will not be considered for assessment until the fee is paid in full. BACS payments are preferred as follows:
