### **Assington Residents Survey Questionnaire Results**

The results of a survey of all households in the Assington parish are below. The response rate was 52% of the adult population, or 174 out of 334 people.

Where appropriate, results are summarised in blue as a percentage of those who agree (i.e. have either ticked "Agree" or "Strongly Agree"), excluding any "No answers". The strength of agreement is also indicated in the yellow summary by weighting "Strongly Agree" to 100%, "Agree" to 66%, "Disagree" to 33% and "Strongly Disagree" to 0%, to give an overall strength of agreement percentage.
