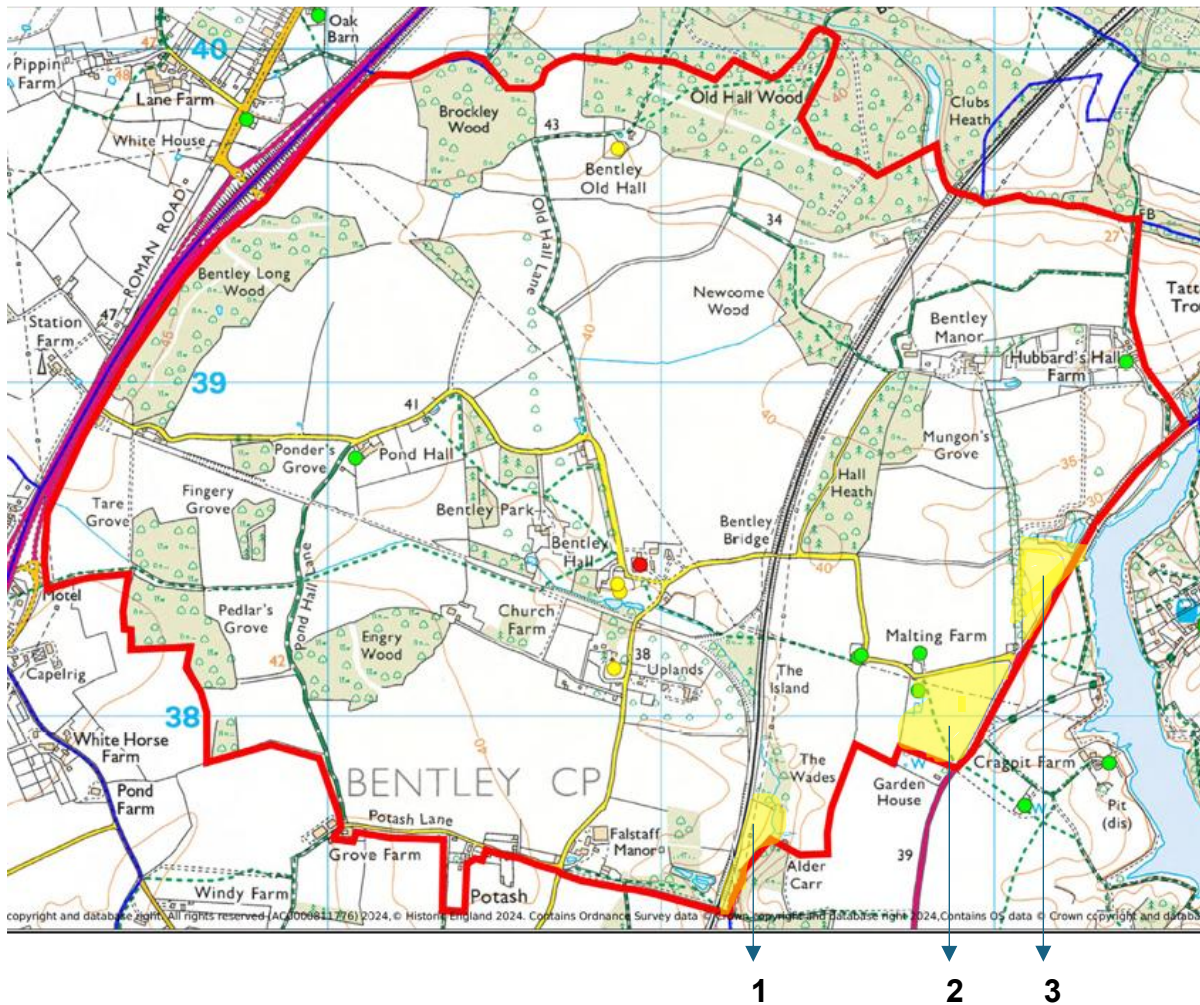


Objection, [REDACTED]

My objection relates to the inclusion [REDACTED] within this proposed Core Conservation Area, [REDACTED] on the map below.



This inclusion does not enhance or protect any of the sites identified in this proposal. As fig 17 of the report illustrates, there are no views on or from these fields.

With the exception of the footpath across area 2, there is no public access through these fields.

These three fields have been significantly changed within living memory with the dominant features now being rail electrification infrastructure, pylons and powerlines. The fields labelled 2 and 3 were reshaped during the 1970s for the construction of the busy A137 road. This is an arbitrary, modern boundary of no relationship to the historic layout.

As the proposal reports (P46 Tree Management), inclusion within this heritage area will place restrictions on farming operations.

In conclusion, the proposal will not enhance the experience for visitors and it will place restrictions [REDACTED]. I request that these [REDACTED] are removed.
