Consultation under Regulation 16 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended) BRETtenham NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN 2024 - 2037

Notice is hereby given that Brettenham Parish Council have submitted a draft Neighbourhood Plan to Babergh District Council which sets out a vision for the parish and contains policies which it intends will be used to help determine planning applications within the designated area.

Consultation on the 'Plan Proposal'

In accordance with Regulation 16 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended), Babergh District Council are consulting on this submission draft plan between Monday 15 July and Friday 30 August 2024.

Written comments are invited from both statutory consultees, and from those who live, work and carry on business in the designated area (the parish) on whether the 'plan proposal' (the submitted Plan) meets the basic condition tests set out in Paragraph 8(1)(a)(2) of Schedule 4B of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 (inserted by the Localism Act 2011).

All comments received will be made publicly available and may be identifiable by name/organisation.
