Submission draft Hintlesham and Chattisham Neighbourhood Plan 2025 - 2040

Notice is hereby given that Hintlesham and Chattisham Parish Council have submitted their draft Neighbourhood Plan to Babergh District Council for consultation and then independent examination. This draft plan sets out a vision for the parish and contains policies which it intends will be used to help determine planning applications in the designated area (the parish).

Consultation on the 'Plan Proposal'

In accordance with Regulation 16 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended), Babergh District Council will be consulting on this submission draft plan between Monday 23 March and Friday 15 May 2026.

Written representations are invited from statutory consultees and from those who live, work and carry on business in the designated area (the parish) on whether or not this submitted Plan meets the 'basic condition tests' that are set out in Paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 4B of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 (inserted by the Localism Act 2011).
